

Hello Property Owners,

As we continue to monitor Hurricane Irma we want to remind everyone that even though a mandatory evacuation has **NOT** been ordered yet, we must still be prepared.

Irma made a shift towards the west this morning, however the Low Country is still bracing to be impacted by the storm. At this time, we are continuing to prepare properties by securing pool furniture, trash cans and any other items not “attached” to the building or grounds. Pool and irrigation systems are being shut down and we plan to begin shutting down elevators around noon tomorrow (Saturday). We are currently taking all measures to secure association records, insurance policies, computers, etc. and will not be able to handle individual personal requests. Once a remote office is established we will send regular e-mail updates to all owners.

Again, if you are in a building with elevators, please note that all elevators will be shut down and locked on upper floors starting at 12pm tomorrow, Saturday, 9/9. This is to avoid damage should the elevator pit get flooded. PLEASE BE SURE TO MAKE USE OF THE ELEVATORS BEFORE THIS TIME.

Atlantic States Management will close at 5pm today to prepare for the possibility of evacuation.
