

With the potential for another hurricane poised to strike the Lowcountry, your Association will try to help keep you up-to-date on the condition of Forest Beach. For those of you who are concerned about your property, but are unable to remain during what may turn in to a mandatory evacuation, or those of you who reside out of the area, the Association will attempt to provide you with property specific conditions provided we have personnel available on the Island and your property is reachable. If you are interested in our assistance in checking on the condition of your property you will need to do one of the following:

Text your name, property address and a cell phone number to 843-247-4781 or

Email your name, property address and a cell phone number to fbassn@aol.com.

Do not attempt to call the number above or the Association's number during any mandatory evacuation as access to phone service will be restricted. The above text number is for messages only.

If there is no damage to your property, you will simply receive a response back indicating that an external inspection of your property did not indicate any area of concern. If there is obvious external evidence of damage or flooding to your property you will be advised as to the extent and sent photos, if possible.

Please note that the Association can not undertake mitigation on your behalf. You will need to contact an appropriate licensed contractor if any work on your property is required.

As not all Forest Beach property owners have subscribed to our email list, please forward this message to any of your neighbors who are property owners in Forest Beach.

If you are remaining on the Island and wish to assist with this effort, please either text or email us your contact information and we will let you know if your assistance can be used.
